


Organizational development usually takes months to show results.

The Five-Day Structure

Each day focuses on one KAIZUNO® step through a one-hour webinar with immediate application:

Immediate application

Between sessions, teams apply each step to their real situation using either manual methods or the digital system for structured evaluation.

Prerequisites for Success

- **Fixed time commitment** - participants must attend all five sessions and work on implementation between them.
